Developer & API Terms of Use

These Developer & API Terms of Use (**Developer Terms**) govern your access to and use of the NexPay application programming interface (the **API**), and any integration you build using it — including the NexPay Zapier integration and the NexPay AI-assistant (MCP) integrations for tools such as Claude and ChatGPT. The API and these integrations form part of the **Services** and are also subject to the NexPay Terms & Conditions; if there is any inconsistency on an API-specific matter, these Developer Terms prevail. They are intended for businesses and partners integrating with NexPay.

1. Definitions

- **API** — the NexPay application programming interface, endpoints, SDKs, documentation and related tools made available by NexPay.
- **Credentials** — API keys, tokens, secrets and other authentication details issued to you.
- **Integration** — any application, workflow or connector you build or operate using the API, including via Zapier or an AI-assistant (MCP) connection.

2. Licence

Subject to these Developer Terms, NexPay grants you a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable and non-sublicensable licence to access and use the API solely to process and manage NexPay payments for NexPay customers, in countries in which NexPay operates. NexPay may issue, modify or revoke Credentials at any time.

3. Acceptable use

You must:

- comply with the current API documentation, integration instructions and any technical or security requirements NexPay specifies;
- use the API only for NexPay customers and for lawful purposes, and not in breach of any law or sanctions;
- not exceed published rate limits, or use the API in a way that may damage, disable, overburden or impair the Services;
- not reverse engineer, decompile or attempt to derive source code from the API except to the extent permitted by law;
- not misrepresent your application as being provided or endorsed by NexPay, and not use NexPay branding except as permitted in writing; and
- obtain and maintain all consents required from any person whose data you submit to NexPay through the API.

4. Credentials and security

You are responsible for keeping your Credentials secure and for all activity that occurs under them. You must not share Credentials, must store them securely, must rotate them periodically and on staff changes, and must notify NexPay immediately at support@nexpay.com.au if you suspect they have been compromised. NexPay may suspend Credentials where it reasonably suspects misuse or a security risk.

5. Availability, rate limits and changes

NexPay may set and change rate limits, throttle, suspend or modify the API, and may release new versions or deprecate older ones, in each case using reasonable efforts to give advance notice of material changes. The API is provided without any uptime or availability warranty beyond what NexPay publishes (for example on its status page).

6. Data protection

Each party will comply with applicable data-protection laws. You must handle personal information obtained through the API in accordance with the NexPay Privacy Policy and applicable law, collect only what is necessary, and not use it for any purpose other than providing the relevant service to the NexPay customer. Where NexPay processes personal information on your behalf, or you on NexPay's behalf, the parties will put appropriate data-processing terms in place.

7. Third-party integrations

The Zapier integration and the AI-assistant (MCP) integrations rely on third-party platforms governed by their own terms and privacy policies. NexPay does not control those platforms and is not responsible for them; your use of them is at your own risk and subject to their terms. You are responsible for what data you allow those platforms to send to, or retrieve from, NexPay.

8. Intellectual property

NexPay and its licensors own all rights in the API, the Services and related documentation. Except for the limited licence in clause 2, these Developer Terms do not grant you any rights in NexPay's intellectual property.

9. Suspension and termination

NexPay may suspend or terminate your access to the API at any time if you breach these Developer Terms, if required for security, legal or regulatory reasons, or as otherwise permitted under the Terms & Conditions. On termination, you must stop using the API and delete your Credentials and any NexPay materials in your control.

10. Warranties, liability and governing law

To the extent permitted by law, the API is provided “as is” and “as available”, and NexPay excludes implied warranties and limits its liability as set out in the Terms & Conditions (including any consumer guarantees that cannot lawfully be excluded). These Developer Terms are governed by the laws of New South Wales, Australia, and you submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of its courts.
